Practice Day:

For those of you that have entered for the Friday practice please see the attached list for the group allocations. If you would like to change groups please let me know a.s.a.p.

We would ask that if you are not riding on the practice day to not enter the circuit until 1pm.

Garages:

We will not be handing out garage keys but will be asking Phillip Island to lock and unlock each night and morning. Please be respectful in the garages, if you have requested half a shed then that is what you get, please do not encroach on another rider's area unless you have asked.

Transponders

At this stage they will be available upon sign in, a deposit will not be required, however if they are not returned within 30 minutes at the end of the meeting you will be billed \$50, if you lose or damage your transponder you are liable to pay for the repairs or full replacement costs as deemed necessary by Computime Race timing Systems Pty Ltd.

Supplementary Regulations & 2024 Series Guidelines

Please make sure that you have all read and understood. They are available on the Hartwell Website or facebook page or you can call the office to have one emailed to you.

Speed and Noise

Speed detection devices will be in use, one in the pit lane and one coming off the circuit at turn 4, if you are found to be excessive you will get a warning, second time occurring your details will be recorded the Third time you will be reported to the Clerk of Course for action.

Noise testing will be conducted if your bike is over 95db you will be told to fix it before you can enter the circuit again.

Numbers

Hartwell Motorcycle Club adheres to the rules in relation to race numbers as they appear in the 2024 MoMs as directed by Motorcycling Australia. Please make sure that you comply. For a little clarity, if a Marshal cannot see your number or timing cannot read your number, you may be black flagged and asked to conform.

Tyres

Under no circumstances are tyres to be left at the circuit. Take them with you!! If there are tyres left, video footage will be sort to find the owners and then they will be fined. Phillip Island fine us and we will certainly pass this on.

Large Vehicles

Vehicles that do not fit thru the tunnel will be able to access from Gap Road at 7am on Friday and Saturday morning and will be able to exit at the completion of racing on Sunday afternoon.

Office Hours

The pit office will be open from 7am each day and close at 5.30pm each day. Any further enquiries can be email to: info@hartwellmcc.org or call 0425 818 729

Scrutineering

Scrutineering for Friday will be self-scrutineer; you will have to sign to say you have checked over your bike. Helmets will be inspected and the build date and serial number will be noted on the sign on sheet so please know what it is and where it is located.

Scrutineering for the race weekend will be carried out on Friday after 3pm and Saturday morning. Scrutineering Cards can be collected from the office at the base of the tower once Sign on is open. A PA announcement will be made to inform that Sign on is open. Collection of your transponder will occur when you sign on. When presenting to scrutineering shed please have your belly pan removed and your transponder fitted. Your helmet must be less than 10 years old and you MUST write your helmet number and build date on your scrutineering card before attending, as this will assist in reducing the time it takes to complete scrutineering. You can attend twice if you wish, once with your bike and once with your gear. You MUST be wearing your leathers. Transponders are also required to be in place for scrutineering.

Rider's Briefing

Rider's briefing will be by electronic means only and are attached to this email. Any further advice to riders will be via PA each morning. When signing on in the morning you will be required to tick a box to state that you have read and understood the rider's briefing notes. The briefing notes will also be available in the pit office.

Final check list:

- You must leave the venue by 6pm each evening. Failure to do this will result in you receiving a bill for the time over.
- When attending the pit office to sign in please have your race licence ready to be viewed. Please make sure that it is current!
- Riders under 18 years of age must have a parent/guardian with them
- Round trophies can be collected at the office on Sunday. Race trophy plates should be collected throughout the weekend and not all at once please.
- Remember don't leave tyres
- · Return your transponders when you have finished your racing weekend
