Heat

The weekend forecast is for some very hot temps make sure you have enough fluids. We will be monitoring the weather and may have to amend our schedule; this will be covered at riders brief. As result of weather prediction we will have riders briefing at 730 and be on track by 800.

Camping

Camping at the circuit cost \$15 per day and is payable directly to Mac Park, you can pay at the time of entry to the practice day on Ridernet or at the club rooms over the weekend. There are no powered sites and the only power is when the generator is started for racing. The canteen does breakfast, lunch and on Saturday night a Dinner (which must be pre ordered at the club rooms or via Ridernet on the practice day). There will be a Trivia/Games night at the club rooms post dinner on Saturday night.

Garages:

The garage list is attached. Remember no microwaves or kettles or high power usage items are to be used in the sheds, as this will trip the generator and turn off tyre warmers.

Transponders

At this stage they will be available upon sign in on Friday afternoon, a deposit will not be required, however if they are not returned within 30 minutes at the end of the meeting you will be billed \$50, if you lose or damage your transponder you are liable to pay for the repairs or full replacement costs as deemed necessary by Computime Race timing Systems Pty Ltd.

Supplementary Regulations & 2024 Series Guidelines

Please make sure that you have all read and understood. They are available on the Hartwell Website or facebook page or you can call the office to have one emailed to you.

Speed and Noise

Speed detection devices will once again be in use, , if you are found to be excessive you will get a warning, second time occurring your details will be recorded the Third time you will be reported to the Clerk of Course for action.

Noise testing will be conducted if your bike is over 95db you will be told to fix it before you can enter the circuit again.

Numbers

Hartwell Motorcycle Club adheres to the rules in relation to race numbers as they appear in the 2024 MoMs as directed by Motorcycling Australia. Please make sure that you comply. For a little clarity, if a Marshal cannot see your number or timing cannot read your number, you may be black flagged and asked to conform.

Tyres

Under no circumstances are tyres to be left at the circuit. Take them with you!! If there are tyres left, video footage will be sort to find the owners and then they will be fined. Mac Park will fine us and we will certainly pass this on.

Scrutineering

Scrutineering for Friday will be at Mac Parks direction;

Scrutineering for the race weekend will be carried out on Friday after 3pm and Saturday morning. Scrutineering Cards can be collected from the office at the 'track entry, once Sign on is open. A PA announcement will be made to inform that Sign on is open. Collection of your transponder will occur when you sign on. When presenting to scrutineering 'bay' please have your belly pan removed and your transponder fitted. Your helmet must be less than 10 years old and you MUST write your helmet number and build date on your scrutineering card before attending, as this will assist in reducing the time it takes to complete scrutineering. You can attend twice if you wish, once with your bike and once with your gear. You MUST be wearing your leathers.

Rider's Briefing

Rider's briefing will be at the Surrendering bay at 0730. When signing on in the morning you will be required to tick a box to state that you have read and understood the rider's briefing notes. The briefing notes will also be available in the pit office.

Final check list:

- **When attending the pit office to sign in please have your race licence ready to be viewed. Please make sure that it is current!**
- **Riders under 18 years of age must have a parent/guardian with them**
- **Round trophies can be collected at the office on Sunday. Race trophy plates should be collected throughout the weekend and not all at once please.**
- **Remember don't leave tyres**
- **Return your transponders when you have finished your racing weekend**
