Welcome to Round 4 of the Hartwell Motorcycle Club Championships. We would like to thank you all for entering and we hope that you have a terrific experience with loads of exciting racing with your fellow competitors.

Garages:

Our garage list has been sent to Champions ride days so people can set up for the race weekend. However: we cannot control the garages on a race practice day. Please be respectful in the garages.

Transponders

At this stage they will be available on Saturday morning from 0730, a deposit will not be required, however if they are not returned within 30 minutes at the end of the meeting you will be billed \$50, if you lose or damage your transponder you are liable to pay for the repairs or full replacement costs as deemed necessary by Computime Race timing Systems Pty Ltd.

Supplementary Regulations & 2024 Series Guidelines

Please make sure that you have all read and understood. They are available on the Hartwell Website or facebook page or you can call the office to have one emailed to you.

Speed and Noise

Speed coming off the track and thru the pits is to be at walking pace. Speed detection devices will be in use, one in the pit lane and one coming off the circuit, if you are found to be excessive you will get a warning, second time occurring your details will be recorded the Third time you will be reported to the Clerk of Course for action.

Noise testing will be conducted if your bike is over 95db you will be told to fix it before you can enter the circuit again.

Numbers

Hartwell Motorcycle Club adheres to the rules in relation to race numbers as they appear in the 2023 MoMs as directed by Motorcycling Australia. Please make sure that you comply. For a little clarity, if a Marshal cannot see your number or timing cannot read your number you may be black flagged and asked to conform.

Tyres

Under no circumstances are tyres to be left at the circuit. Take them with you!! If there are tyres left, video footage will be sort to find the owners and then they will be fined. We get fined and we will certainly pass this on.

Vehicles in Pit Lane

Vehicles are to be clear of Pit Lane by 0830 on Saturday and Sunday mornings and are not permitted back in until the completion of racing that day.

Office Hours

The pit office will be open from 7am each day and close at 5.30pm each day. Any further enquiries can be email to: info@hartwellmcc.org or call 0425 818 729. Some of our usual helpers are a bit under the weather at the moment so please be patient and curious.

Scrutineering

Scrutineering for the race weekend will be carried out on Friday after 4:30pm and Saturday morning from 7:00. Have your belly pan removed, Your helmet must be less than 10 years old. **You also MUST write your helmet number and build date on your scrutineering card** prior as this will expedite scrutineering. You can attend twice if you wish, once with your bike and once with your gear. You MUST be wearing your leathers. (you can maybe call into scrutineering after your last session and get your gear checked then bring your bike down later when it has cooled down). Transponders are not required to be in place for scrutineering due to availability.

Rider's Briefing

Rider's briefing will be at the office at a time to be determined. Any further advice to riders will be via PA each morning. The briefing notes will also be available in the pit office.

Camping

Camping is permitted at the track at a cost of \$10 per person/per night, Please inform the office staff.

Final check list:

- **When attending the pit office to sign in please have your race licence ready to be viewed. Please make sure that it is current!**
- **Riders under 18 years of age must have a parent/guardian with them**
- **Round trophies from Round 3 and previous years can be collected at the office on Saturday and Sunday. Race plates should be collected throughout the weekend and not all at once please.**
- **Remember don't leave tyres**
- **Return your transponders when you have finished your racing weekend**
