

FORMULA 4002016 CLASS DESCRIPTION GUIDE

General

'Formula 400' class machines must adhere to the GCR's for the applicable sections in the General and Road Race chapters.

Class

Formula 400

- a) The bike must be manufactured pre 2000
- b) No modification main frame, triple clamps or front forks (external)
- c) Standard Wheel front and rear, no lightweight rims
- d) No Fuel Injection or Turbo charging
- e) No fuel additives beyond 100 RON
- f) No removal of starter system
- g) Minimum weight of 150kg with tank removed
- h) Allowable stock class items carry over to Super mod,
- i) Engine bore and stroke within capacity limits refer GCR 12.4.5 2008

Formula Specific Rules:

Any modification not stated as allowable is deemed as not allowed.

	Allowable Modifications
Engine	Non Permitted. Engine bore and stroke within capacity limits
Carburettors	Quick action throttle Re-jetted, CV or flat slides. Air box / Air Filter / Filter removed Ram air / Air Scoops
Exhaust	Aftermarket Exhaust system
Electrical	Rev Delimiter Aftermarket temp gage and taco Modified wiring loom Lightened charge System / Total Loss Modified Aftermarket CDI Aftermarket Ignition Coils
Frame	Steering Damper Altered or replacement of sub frame Footrests, Handlebars and levers.

Cooling	Modified cooling system Aftermarket radiators / radiators from another model of bike.
Suspension	Ride height adjuster Non-standard ford internals (external to remain same for model of bike). Aftermarket rear shock or shock from other model of bike.
Brakes	Aftermarket brake lines / master cylinders Aftermarket rotors to the same diameter
Bodywork	Aftermarket fairings and screen Duct tape / Zip Ties / mildly offensive stickers
Wheels	17" Rear same make, equivalent weight.
